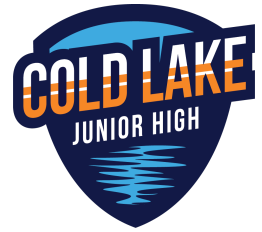

GRADE 8 SUPPLY LIST **2022 - 2023**

* It would be greatly appreciated if all items listed below could be **LABELED** prior to the start of school. Thank you!

* **Paper, pencils, and pens are the supplies that students most frequently misplace or deplete. It is suggested that part of their supply be kept at home and restocked regularly as needed.**

- **EARBUDS/HEADPHONES** (to be left at school)
- pencil crayons and markers
- 500 sheets of loose-leaf (to be replenished when needed) 1 pack for Science
- 1 package of 8 ½ x 11 blank white paper (to be given to the teacher for student doodling and artwork)
- 4 x 2" ring binders
- 2 lined coil notebooks (Math/Sci)
- 4 packages of dividers (2 are for:Math/Sci)
- good quality scissors
- glue stick
- blue or black pens (to be replenished as needed)
- HB pencils (to be replenished as needed)
- Erasers
- Personal pencil sharpener
- pencil case
- highlighters - 4 different colours (Math/Sci)
- sticky notes - 4 different colours (Math/Sci)
- whiteboard markers - 4 different colours (Math/Sci)
- small (lap-sized) dry erase board (standard 9"x12") (Math/Sci)
- 1 pkg clear page protectors (Math/Sci)
- 2 packages of 200 index cards (Math/Sci)
- highlighter (ELA/SS)
- 2 packages of graph paper 1 cm X 1 cm or smaller (Math/Sci)
- ruler
- calculator (basic – a scientific calculator is **NOT** required)
- 1 **geometry set** (fairly good quality) - Staedtler is the best choice
- 3 boxes of Kleenex (to be given to homeroom teacher)
- white out stick (****NOT** liquid**)
- Clothing for the weather (proper winter gear and footwear for outdoor use; Outdoor Ed)

- Set of camping utensils/dishware (can be purchased from the dollar store/walmart; Outdoor Ed)
- 2 duotangs (home ec. & health)
- 1 medium sized plastic container for taking home food (home ec)
- 1 personal size hand sanitizer (optional)
- Chromebook (**optional** as students have access to Chromebooks at school)

In order to keep a clean, dust-free building, we are recommending that students have 2 pairs of shoes. Wet, dirty footwear should be removed. Please get footwear that does not scuff the floors.
